The unit applies to all persons who may be required to provide a first aid response in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings.

Course Outcomes

Students will develop the skills and knowledge to provide a first aid response to a casualty in relation to recognising an emergency situation, preparing for and performing first aid procedures, and communicating and reviewing incident details; identifying and assessing risk or injury, providing first aid in accordance with first aid principles, and undertaking incident reporting and review procedures.

Does this course suit you?

The course applies to all students who may be required to provide a first aid response in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings. They may or may not be currently employed.

Whilst this course is primarily marketed to people employed as first aiders and those with a duty of care to provide first aid to others, those who are not employed or providing services under a volunteer arrangement are still catered for.

Student Commitment:

Students will need to be able to demonstrate they have the necessary skills to recognise and assess an emergency situation, perform CPR in accordance with relevant guidelines, provide relevant and effective first aid procedures, operate first aid equipment, accurately report details of an incident, and engage emergency services where required. .

Before and during the training, it is vital that participants commit extra time to study course materials. This will ensure that they have the best chance possible of completing the assessment exam.

Delivery Methodology

Workplace

Training

Assessment

Skills and knowledge must be assessed in the context of the student's work environment.

In this course, we use the following:

- knowledge assessment (theory short answer questions)
- practical assessment (demonstration and observation)



Intake, Entry Requirements & Duration

Program Duration

- Pre-course study (Online Tutorials) - 2 Hours, plus
- Face to Face Training & Assessment – 2 Days (this may be reduced or extended dependent upon student's prior experience and uptake of skills and knowledge)

For quality purposes, the RTO must determine the amount of training it provides to each participant.

Entry Requirements

It is important to note that the HLTAID competency standards require a level of **physical ability** to meet the evidence requirements for assessment. These standards relate to the level of performance required to provide resuscitation and respond to an emergency situation where there may be risk to life.

Due to the potential risk to health and safety where a nominated first aider, or worker with duty of care, does not have the ability to perform resuscitation and/or first aid to the performance standard; it is not appropriate to issue a Statement of Attainment to students who are physically unable to meet the assessment requirements - a Certificate of Participation will be issued instead.

Course Resources

Equipment required to train and assess will be available. Talented Training will provide a classroom and practical training area for delivery and assessment along with relevant materials for delivery and assessment.

Equipment used for this course include:

- Adult and infant resuscitation manikins
- adrenaline auto-injector training device
- AED training devices
- Workplace first aid kit,
- Placebo bronchodilator and spacer device
- Different types of wound dressings and bandages,
- Blankets and items to treat for shock
- Workplace injury, trauma or illness record, or other applicable workplace or site incident report form.

Course Intake

This course is delivered on an as-needed basis.

Talented Training will verify each student's appropriateness for the course during the pre-enrolment communications.

Participants should have a good level of literacy and numeracy so they can read, adjust work methods in response to changing weather and site conditions, identify workplace hazards, speak clearly and directly, listen carefully to instructions and information, read and interpret work instructions and safety signs; and complete first aid paperwork appropriate to the workplace (e.g. first aid casualty reports)

Course documentation

On successful completion of this unit of competency, the student will receive a Statement of Attainment for *HLTAID011 Provide First Aid*.



Recognising previous work and learning

Whilst Talented Training has a Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) Policy to ensure that an applicant's skills and knowledge gained through formal and informal education and training, work experience, and/or life experience (including volunteer work; committee responsibilities, family duties and hobbies) are recognised, students will still be required to undergo both the theory and practical assessment for this course. The training component may however, be reduced according to the level of prior experience.

Supporting our Students' Needs

Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) – an LLN assessment is issued as part of a student's induction pack and administered prior to training commencement, with results recorded against each of the 5 core skill areas.

Results of these assessments are discussed individually with each student.

Disability – students self-identify on their enrolment forms.

On the occasions where Talented Training trainers do not receive the enrolment forms directly, Talented Training administration staff will communicate this information to them for following up with the student.

Welfare – students may alert their trainer to additional support needs required.

Trainers and/or administration staff may be alerted to a problem (or potential problem) through student communication or witnessing specific behaviour of concern. On these occasions, trainers are encouraged to be the central contact person with the student about support, on behalf of the RTO.
